Sealed bids will be received at the office of the County Auditor of Wright County, Iowa, until **10:00 o'clock a.m., on the 26th day of July 2021**, for the supplying of materials and labor for the construction of an improvement project described in general as **"DRAINAGE DISTRICT NO. 194 LATERAL 1 TILE REPAIRS, WRIGHT COUNTY, IOWA"**, and as described in detail in the Plans and Specifications for said improvements now on file in the office of the Auditor.

Bids will be opened at the Wright County Board of Supervisors' Board Room, promptly after the time for receiving the bids has closed.

Each Proposal shall be made on a blank form furnished by the Engineer or a true and correct copy thereof and each Proposal shall be sealed and plainly identified, and shall be accompanied in a separate envelope by a Bid Bond, certified check, cashier's check, or a Certified Share Draft in a separate sealed envelope in an amount equal to ten percent (10%) of the total bid, in no case to exceed \$10,000, drawn on and certified by a bank in Iowa or a certified share draft drawn on a Credit Union in Iowa or chartered under the laws of the United States of America. The Certified Check, Cashier's Check or Certified Share Draft shall be made payable to the Auditor of Wright County, Iowa as security that, if awarded a contract by Resolution of the Board of Supervisors acting as Trustees for Drainage District No. 194, Wright County, Iowa, the Bidder will enter into a contract at the prices bid and furnish the required corporate surety bond. The Certified Check, Cashier's Check, or Certified Share Draft may be cashed and the proceeds retained by the Sub Drainage District as liquidated damages if the Bidder fails to execute a contract or file the required surety bond within ten (10) calendar days after the acceptance of Bidder's Proposal by Resolution of the Board. Certified checks or certified share drafts will be returned to the unsuccessful Bidders within sixty (60) days after the opening of

Bids. No Bidder may withdraw a proposal within sixty (60) days after the date set for opening bids.

The proposed improvements to be considered shall in general consist of:

- 1. Replacing approximately 1,652 LF of clay tile with reinforced concrete pipe that is 36 inches in diameter and equivalent concrete arch pipe and associated work items.
- 2. Crushing and burying existing tile.
- 3. Installing one (1) tee and riser intake.

All work and materials are to be in strict compliance with the Plans and Specifications and proposed form of Contract now on file in the office of the County Auditor of Wright County, Iowa. Bidders who return full sets of the Bidding Documents in good condition (suitable for re-use) within 14 days after award of the project will receive a full refund. If they are not returned, or returned past the deadline, or are not in a reusable condition as judged by the Engineer, the deposit shall be forfeited. Checks for Bidding Documents shall be payable to "McClure Engineering Company".

The successful Bidder will be required to furnish a Performance Bond in an amount equal to 100% of the contract price to the County Auditor guaranteeing the faithful performance for the contract and

guaranteeing the completed project against defective workmanship and/or materials for a period of one (1) year from and after acceptance.

Payment to the Contractor for said work will be made in monthly estimates and one final estimate in accordance with Section 468.100 of the Code of Iowa. Monthly estimates will be equivalent to ninety percent (90%) of the contract value of the work completed during the preceding calendar month. The Contractor will prepare on or before the last day of each month, estimates of work completed during the preceding calendar month under the contract and shall submit these to the Engineer who will certify each approved estimate to the County Auditor for payment. Such monthly payment will in no way be construed as an act of acceptance for any of the work partially or totally completed.

Payments shall be made in cash or warrants in favor of such contractor on the drainage fund of the District, which if registered and stamped "not paid for want of funds" shall bear interest at a rate of six (6%) percent in accordance with Chapter 468.70 of the Code of Iowa.

The Contractor shall complete all work in accordance with the Plans and Specifications **by April 11, 2022** and the Contractor shall forfeit **\$200.00** per working day as required to complete the contract after the aforesaid completion date, except in the condition that a time extension is granted by the Board of Supervisors. A working day as used herein shall be defined as any day, Monday through Friday, not a holiday, during which weather conditions shall permit a full crew to be gainfully employed for a full 8-hour shift between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m..

The Board of Supervisors hereby reserves the right to reject any or all bids, to waive informalities and irregularities as it may deem to be for the best interests of the Drainage District.

Wherever you buy canning supplies, follow tips for safe food preservation

Home food preservation – canning, freezing and drying food at home – increased during the 2020 pandemic, causing shortages in both canning jars and lids. The trends continue in 2021: increased home food preservation, and shortages of canning jars and lids in some areas.

However, if you are wondering where to buy canning jars and lids, the best option still may be your local retail store, not online, according to the Human Sciences Extension and Outreach food preservation team at Iowa State University.

For example, according to FreshPreserving.com, the website for Ball brand home canning products, these products are currently only sold through authorized third-party retailers. The company announced in June that it had increased jar and lid production to replenish stock at retail stores as quickly as possible. The FreshPreserving.com site includes a “where to buy” feature and a list of authorized retail partners.

Wherever you buy your home canning supplies, ISU Extension and Outreach nutrition and wellness specialists



recommend these tips on lids for safe and successful home canning:

Refer to the manufacturer’s recommendations for shelf life on lids. If you choose to use lids beyond the recommended shelf life, please note they may not seal.

Off-brand or generic lids may not be reliable. Reports indicate they may have less metal and less sealing compound.

If you choose to use off-brand lids, consider using water bath canning only, not pressure canning. Keep in mind that the product still may not seal.

ISU Extension and Outreach and the National Center for Home Food Preservation do not recommend using reusable lids at this time. Testing of the Tattler Reusable Canning Lids brand is currently underway.

Sandy McGrath with Wright County Public Health gave an update on the COVID cases in Wright County. There are 3 new positive cases since last week with a total of 1,863 since March 2020. By residents in Wright County, 241 have had their 1st dose, 4,478 have received their 2nd dose and 893 that have received the one dose Johnson & Johnson vaccine.
